Course Aim

To enable youth leaders to train, lead and supervise young people in expedition related activities. The Award has been specifically designed to meet the needs of BB and GB leaders involved in training groups for the Duke of Edinburgh's Award.

The course begins with a training weekend in May and concludes with an assessment weekend in September. Attendance at both weekends is required

Entry Requirements

- Expedition & Outdoor Leadership Certificate Level 1 is required.
- BB Registration.

Notes

Candidates must be registered with Brigade Headquarters prior to this course. If not already registered (eg as a helper, warrant officer or staff sergeant) please complete Leader Registration Form (LREG1).

This certificate is a requirement for those training or supervising expeditions. The certificate is valid for 5 years, and can be renewed by submitting evidence of continued involvement in expedition activity. The level 2 certificate is for those leaders training and supervising expeditions in wild country (eg DofE Gold Award).

Confirmation of places booked will be sent by email only – to the Captain if an address is supplied. Confirmation and course programme will be posted direct to each applicant approximately one week before course.

Registrations can only be accepted by receipt of completed form and payment.
