The Boys' Brigade National Competitions give COMPANIES the opportunity to compete with other COMPANIES in sporting challenges.

The sports are:

- Badminton (team of four) plus 1 reserve permitted
- Chess (team of three) plus 1 reserve permitted
- Five a side Football (Junior) (five from a squad of eight)
- Five a side Football (Senior) (five from a squad of eight)
- Masterteam (maximum of four) plus 1 reserve permitted
- Table Tennis (team of three) plus 1 reserve permitted

The age limits are:

- Company Section and Senior members (**Staff Sergeants not eligible**) that have been born on or after **01.09.2000** except for Five a side Football below
- ⇒ Five a side Football (Junior) where Company Section Boys must have been born on or after **01.09.2004**
- ⇒ Five a side Football (Senior) where Boys must have been born between **01.09.2000** and **31.8.2004**

Amicus Groups and Girls Association can take part in Masterteam, Chess, Badminton and Table Tennis subject to the above age limits. A company is permitted to enter more than one team per event, but please note that no allowances can be made to ensure game clashes are alleviated. Integrity of team membership for each company will be assumed.

The entry fee for each competition is £8.00 per team.

Each competing Company must nominate a person who will receive the correspondence for **all** competitions that are entered. The name and contact details of the nominated person will appear in the official competitions directory.

Masterteam Rounds

These will be by 10.11.2018, by 8.12.2018 and by 23.02.2019.

Joint Football Teams - a separate entry form is required with full contact details.
